30	Monday	Payment for regular registration is due before 3:30 p.m. on the Web (https://arrow.ulm.edu) or at LA Capitol Federal Credit Union on Northeast Drive. A bill must be obtained on the Web. Classes will be dropped for non-payment.

2	Wednesday	Warhawk Express available for Summer II.
3-8	Thursday-Tuesday	Late Registration and Add/Drop of classes on ARROW is 6:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. and 7:00 p.m.-12:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. to 12:00 a.m. (\$50 late fee). June 8 is the last date to add a course and the payment deadline is on June 11 before 3:30 p.m. La Capitol Federal Credit Union on Northeast Drive.
4	Friday	Independence Day Holiday – University Offices closed.
6	Sunday	Residence halls open for Summer II move-in. Students must be registered for classes and all fees paid before checking into a residence hall.
7	Monday	Summer II Classes begin – University Offices open from 7:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Food services facilities open 7:00 a.m. - 7:00 p.m.
8	Tuesday	Last date to add a course (6:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. and 7:00 p.m.-12:00 a.m.). NOTE: If course load is reduced after this date, a refund is <u>not</u> applicable. A partial refund applies only for resignation. “W” grade will be issued for courses dropped after this date and course(s) will remain on the student’s schedule for fee calculation purposes.
9	Wednesday	Payment for Late Registration and Add/Drop of courses is due before 3:30 p.m. on the Web (https://arrow.ulm.edu) or at LA Capitol Federal Credit Union on Northeast Drive. A bill must be obtained on the Web. Classes will be dropped for non- payment.
10	Thursday	Classes may not be dropped or added on this date to facilitate processing of financial aid.
